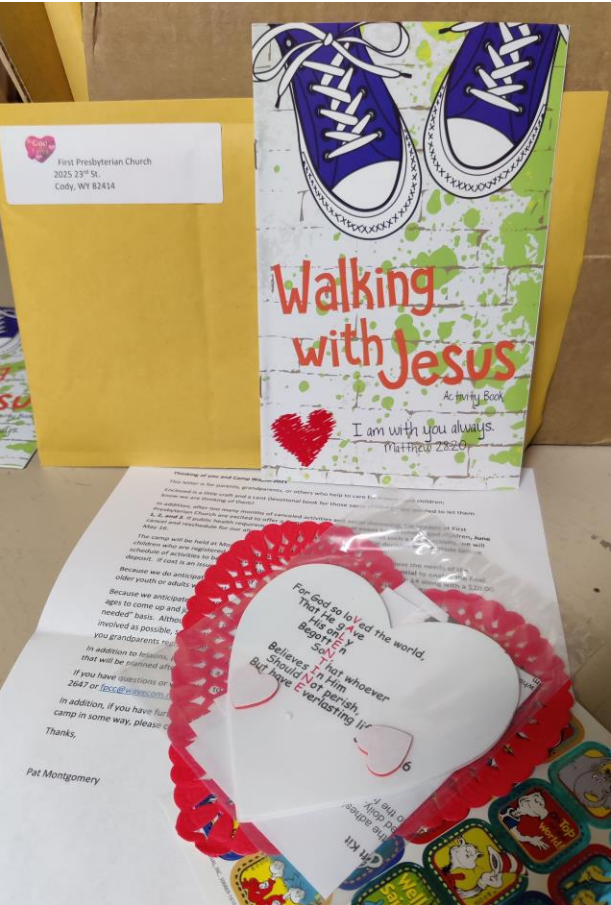
Book Study Opportunities:
